

## **SDN Collaborative Group**

Expressions of Interest are invited for participation in the new SDN Collaborative Group. This will provide ideas and support for the SDN program and SDN Coordinator. We are aiming for between 5 and 7 people (including the Coordinator). It is envisioned that the Group will reflect a balance based on gender, ethnicity, and the city-country divide.

Members can decide how much time they spend, when they wish to end their work, etc. The Group will have an action-orientation - ideas backed by a commitment to action – with the potential for capacity-building for members of the Group. An essential criteria is previous attendance at an SDN workshop.

## Guidelines for the Group:

- 1. Identify core Social Developers Network principles and processes and develop a unique selling point (USP) for the SDN to explain to a newcomer what SDN is about.
- 2. Identify opportunities for connections and relationships that go beyond SDN and recommend how SDN can help participants integrate outcomes in their community, personal life and work.
- Develop a creative archive for SDN that tells visual, audio and written narratives that can motivate people to become involved and attend workshops and other SDN events.
- 4. Identify the top 2-3 action learning projects for expanding the influence of SDN, informed by SDN ethos and NED values (\*), with funding if needed (e.g. produce a mini doco video about SDN).
- 5. Assist and support the Coordinator to carry out existing commitments and develop his/her role in the light of the above (e.g. volunteer to organise regional workshops in their local area).
- 6. In the spirit of the SDN, the Group will encourage a regenerative process that creates a positive and supportive experience for members and is recognised as of value to all.
